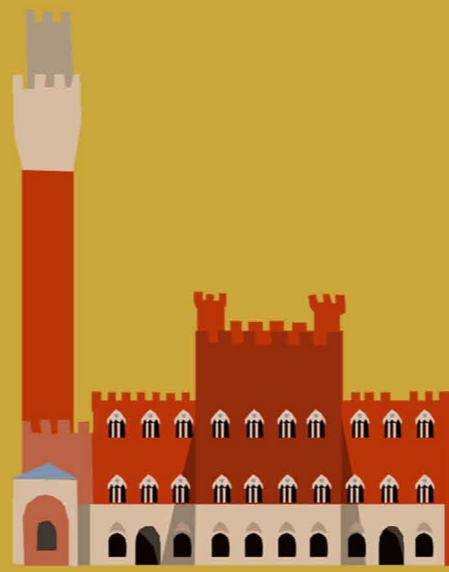


LOVELY Val D'Orcia
